

Primary Remote Learning - Guide for Parents

In the event of any pupils needing to be absent from school due to Covid-19, all work will be set using SMHW/ Satchel One for all pupils. We have made some changes to last year, however, to provide more immediate feedback and personal tuition for pupils. For Reception pupils and anyone else who has joined the School this year, log in details will be sent home separately next week. Scenarios Where Remote Learning Will Be Needed

The information below provides an outline of how work will be set and in what format in different scenarios.

1. An individual pupil is absent from school, due to the need to self-isolate

Class teachers will be uploading resources from lessons delivered in class on a daily basis to SMHW. This will be in the format of an uploaded PowerPoint presentation for English and Maths and any Topic work that has been used for teaching that day. All PPTs will have a slide that explains the task that your child will need to complete, and it will be clearly labelled with the word 'task' on one of the slides. There may also be additional resources provided from a range of sources to support your child via video links or further learning tasks.

In this scenario, it will not be possible for teachers to provide individual feedback, as they will still be teaching your child's classes in school, but all the work will be provided. If your child is really struggling though, please do contact us, and we will do all we can to support.

2. A group of pupils have been asked to remain at home by the School.

Whilst we are not expecting this to happen, the following would also apply to any school closures if the national guidance changed.

In this scenario, we will setting pre-recorded lessons; these will be in a video format and will be delivered by your child's class teacher. At several points during each video lesson, your child will be asked to complete a task, just as they would in school. These will be indicated by a phrase like '*now pause the video and complete the task, when you have finished carry on watching the lesson*', at these points the video will need to be paused and the work on the screen completed. If your child is unsure about something, this means they can easily rewind the lesson and watch a section again. These lessons will be pre-recorded and uploaded on a daily basis to SMHW. This means that a pupil can access the learning from home on the day it is intended but, in any order, and at any time.

Your child's class teacher will also be available for any additional support and feedback using SMHW as a feedback and chat platform. This will not be a live lesson, as the lesson will already have been provided as a video, but as a means of supporting any children who may need help and as a platform for feedback at the following times:

- **9.30am – 10.15am:** Maths support and feedback
- **11.00am – 11.45am:** English support and feedback
- **1pm-2pm:** Topic support and feedback

We would like to thank parents for their continued support and understanding in this ever-evolving environment. We are confident that this revised way of setting work will be even more productive for you and your child in the event of any pupils or bubbles needing to isolate.
