



## 16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

As of 24<sup>th</sup> February 2021, CFS has been in receipt of £394 from the 16-19 Tuition Fund.

It has been used to support four students who did not achieve a Grade 4 in either or both English Language or Maths at GCSE in August 2019. Two of these students are disadvantaged. Three of those students have now achieved at least a Grade 4 in both subjects, through paid additional support including lesson taught outside of the normal timetable by internal part time teaching staff.

We have also used the 16-19 fund to support the whole cohort with academic mentors to aid with their learning strategies, revision techniques, UCAS applications and wider careers support. This mentorship programme has been 1-1 in support, with both face to face and virtual meetings, and sourcing extra revision material and resources, addressing the disruption created through Covid. 75% of this group are currently awaiting offers from a wide range of Universities and colleges.
