Dear all,

Further to the email on Sunday, we can confirm CFS' plans for the two strike days planned by the NEU on Wednesday 3rd July and Friday 5th July. In fact, due to some other changes that week that have been necessary because of the two strike days, for clarity we have outlined the whole week's events for each year group. You can access your child's year group plan via the links below.

It is important to note that the following plan has been based on ensuring safety in school with the absolute knowns, and also exploring common sibling pairings across year groups to support with any childcare issues on the two strike days. You will see that some year groups have been more impacted than others – this is not reflective of which staff are or are not striking, as this is often not known until the day itself. Instead we have considered safety levels with the other known variables in school that week and, quite simply, not all year groups will need to have a day at home across the two days. It would be wrong of course to do this, just to ensure it is 'fair', but we will consider which year groups have been more affected should there be any further industrial action next term.
