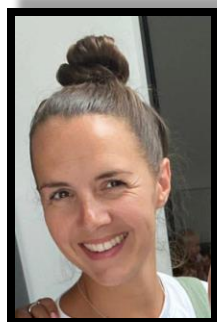

## Four Themes

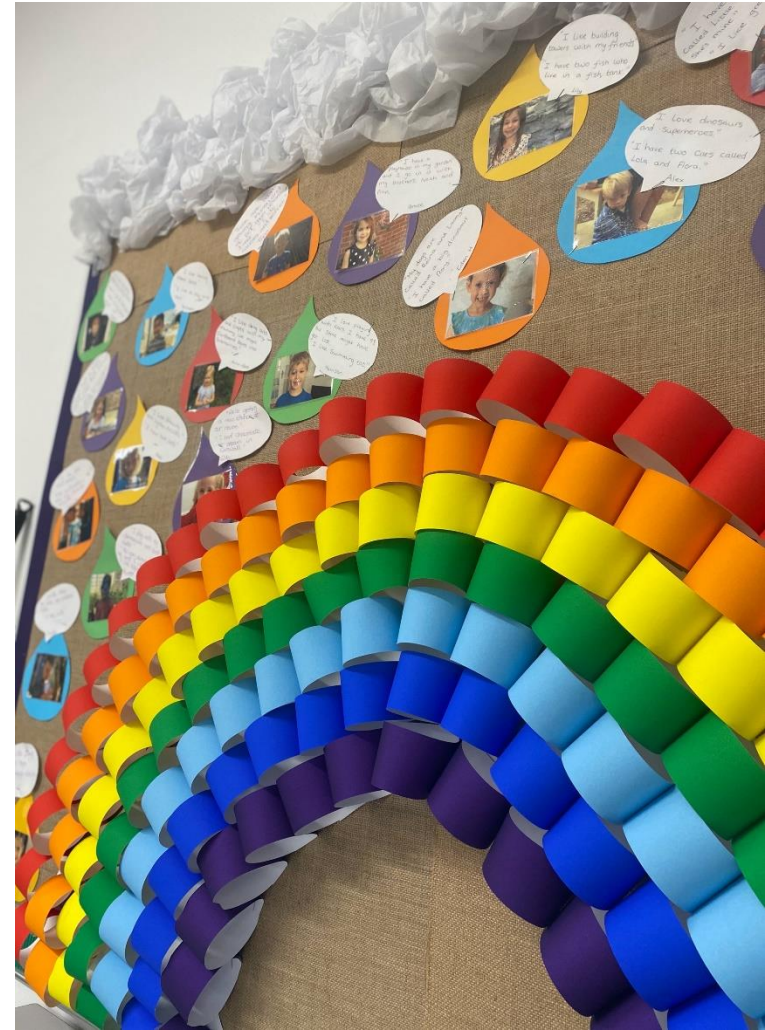
- A Unique Child

# ***A Typical CFS School Day in EYFS***

- 08:35 Doors open – early morning activities (linked provision)
- 08:45 Gates/doors close
- 09:00 Register
- 09:10 Phonics input followed by 'explore time'
- 11:00 Maths followed by lunch routine
- 11:30 Lunch served to Year R
- 12:00 Playtime
- 12:50 calm time – singing and stories
- 13:00 Topic/PE/Handwriting/PPA cover
- 14:00 Tidy time. End of Day Routine
- 14:45 Doors open
