Earning this award is a powerful reflection of everything you have experienced, achieved, and become since joining us. It showcases your growth, your challenges, your successes, and the unique journey that has shaped who you are today.

The Gold Award is more than a certificate—it’s a lifelong record of your story. It highlights the skills you’ve built, the opportunities you have embraced, and the character you have developed along the way. It is something you can proudly share with sixth form schools, colleges, apprenticeships, universities, and future employers as proof of your commitment, ambition, and achievements. **This is your chance to celebrate your journey!**

Application format: Below are a number of questions that will help you consider what you will want to say. You do not have to answer all of the questions. How you say what you want to say is up to you. You could apply through either a Personal Reflective Statement, through a video or audio application speech, or through a short interview that you have prepped for.

Application content: Use Unifrog to help you with the content that you might consider about your time here and the progress you have made. On Unifrog you have your ‘Interactions’ tab which outlines many of the things you have done whilst at CFS. You may have done other things too which you could talk about. It also has a record of your Work Experience placement (by all means ask for your booklet too) and can give you an idea about what you could do as a future career. But you don’t have to use Unifrog - you could also use recent progress reports, learning profile scores and/or experiences outside of school.

Application deadline: You can apply at any time before **8th May**, sending Personal statements, video/audio applications or requesting an interview you have prepped for to rangell@chichesterfreeschool.org.uk
