Club Descriptions:

- **Supervised Study; Years 7 - 13** This is a chance for pupils to independently catch up with homework, study or reading in a room that is supervised by one of our Senior Leadership Team in the Secondary dining hall. Once timetable they will be expected to arrive for supervised study prepared for an hour's study or reading in a quiet environment. Any absences must be reported to absence@chichesterfreeschool.org.uk this is not a drop-in session.
- **Everything English; Year 2** Each week we will spend time exploring different areas of English- this could be creative writing, listening to stories, spelling games, handwriting and much more. Come along and explore the wonderful world of Everything English!
- **Football with Chichester College - Years 3 & 4, Years 5&6 and Years 1 & 2;** This club is overseen by the Head Coach of Chichester College (on site monitoring at all times) and actively run by 3rd Year students working towards their Level 3 Football Coaching Qualification. Get the very best advice on improving your football skills and fitness. The club is run on the school's astro pitch come rain or shine so appropriate clothing must be worn at all times. **The cost is Mondays £30, Wednesdays £33 and Fridays £30 for the term. - **Film Club (different year groups on differing days);** Chill out and watch the latest available PG Films. **Subscription for this term is £10 (for each weekday).**
- **Movie Making Club – Years 9 & 10;** Try out your camerawork and editing skills as we look at iconic scenes from great movies and recreate them.
- **Cartoon Drawing Club – Year 2;** Learn to draw your favourite cartoon characters, this will help with your important pencil holding and control skills.
- **Lego Club Years 1 - 4;** An important developmental club encouraging fine motor skills and simple construction decisions while enhancing social skills in a safe and secure manner. Dizzy Ducklings is an external provider. **The cost for this term is £48 payable to Dizzy Ducklings.**
- **Contemporary Dance & Yoga with Miss Emmy - Years 1 & 2;** *Everyone must book! Lets get moving, lets get creative!* A fun and exciting contemporary class for little movers, they will be learning movement combinations with creative exploration! Dance, be creative and have fun! Yoga at the end of each class to stretch those muscles that have been working hard, a great way to end the day! Cost for the term is **£51.**
- **Times Table Club – Years 3 & 4;** Rock Stars to the ready....
- **Debating Club – Year 7;** join the conversation and the team to debate the issue most close to your heart. Future competitions are at stake. **Cost for this term £3.**
- **Knitting Club - Years 9 & 10;** Learn to knit, learn some new stitches and techniques. Make your own hand knitted flowers, hats, phone covers, scarves or whatever you wish to knit. Be the envy of all your friends because you can make your own unique accessories. Learn to read a pattern and design your own.

- **Hip Hop Club with RnB Dance - Years 7 & 8;** learn and perform routines to your favourite tunes with Rachael from RnB Dance. **Cost for this term is £48**
- **Tribal – Years 5 & 6; Tribal Club** - Working through a number of activities including: lifting, shifting, carrying, dragging, pulling and running as well as a mixture of cardio exercises to music. Please note: this is an outdoor sports session come rain or shine, please ensure that your son or daughter is sent in to school that day with the necessary kit to keep them dry and warm. This is an external provided club run by Tribal Sports Events. **The cost is £54.**
- **Multisports (not football) with Activ8 - Years 1 & 2;** Learn a variety of team sports which help build confidence, balance, hand-eye co-ordination. This is an outside club whatever the weather, please wear appropriate all-weather clothing. Cost for this term is **£44** (paid half termly, sibling discount available)
- **Sama Karate - Years 1 & 2;** A disciplined non-contact karate club. An external provider, Sama Karate, run this club. This is a turn up and pay club and a weekly payment of £5 cash is required on the day. After 4 weeks of initial settling in a payment of £20 is required to join the club and includes insurance. Uniform can be bought from the club ranging from £23-£60. This club works towards Karate grading, which occurs every other month at a different location at a cost of £20, belts are £5 and can be bought on the day of grading once they have been awarded.

- **Ukulele Club To the Music of...– Year 5;** Learn to play the ukulele. Ukulele's can be provided if you don't have your own, BUT you will need to practise at home and will not be able to take a school instrument home. Cost for this term is **£15 Minimum of 10 people for this club to take place.**
- **Yoga- Years 5 & 6;** Relax with a downward facing dog or a resting cat with Miss Marshall
- **Musical Theatre with Theatre Arts UK - Years 3 & 4;** Through learning to sing and dance, Theatre Arts UK will support your child in learning to discover a self-confidence you never knew they had and to learn to believe in themselves while they learn new skills and have fun with friends. **The cost for this term is £47.30**
- **Drama Theatre with Theatre Arts Uk – Years 5 & 6;** Looking to learn skills and build your confidence for that all-important audition? Here is a place to start. **The cost for this term is £51.30 Advanced notice ; This starts on the 13th January.**
- **French Fun with Mme Slater - Years 3 & 4;** Spend a fun hour learning the basics of French. **Cost for this term is £49.50** please bring in a cheque written to Ms Slater for the amount on the first day back of term
- **Instrument Club To the Music of... - Years 7 & 8;** A music club for everyone. Whether you can already play a musical instrument or not it does not matter as Mr Cotten will help you learn.
- **Signing Choir Club – To the Music of... Years 7 & 8;** Learn to sign the words of song in school, practise both singing and signing at home.
- **Cricket – Years 9 & 10;** Net practise for the new season.

- **Deepen your History Knowledge through films – Years 9 & 10:** . We will be exploring the topics studied in your GCSE unit through the use of films and documentaries. This is designed to deepen your understandings and explore wider world context, this in turn will help consolidate your understanding in the classroom. These include films such as 'the Help', '13 Days', '12 Years a Slave' and many more. This will be designed around Paper 1 so America 1920-73 and Conflict and Tension between East and West 1945-72
- **Designers Club – Years 9 & 10;** Develop your designing skills to become a creative problem solver and master designer. In this club you will be using the full iterative design process to create new products for real problems. Each half term I will give you a context (theme), you will identify a product that you want to design for that context and then, using a range of materials, make a prototype of your product. **This is not a craft club**, though you will be learning how to build skilfully made models and prototypes using papers, cards, woods, textiles and polymers. We will be working in our design studio to give you access to everything that our GCSE Design and Technology students use for their projects. **Cost is £3.**
- **School Production & Shakespeare Competition – Years 7 & 8 and 9 & 10;** Working on all things dramatic.
- **Recorder Club – To the Music of... Year 4;** Learn to play the recorder nicely.
- **SATS Revision – Year 6;** By invite ONLY
- **Festive Art & Craft Club – Year 5;** Making seasonal crafts. **Cost is £5.**
- **Coding Club Year 4;** Learn and practise the very basics of computer programming.
- **Dungeons and Dragons Years 9 & 10 and Years 7 & 8;** a fantasy table-top role-playing game. The core of D&D is storytelling. You and your friends tell a story together, guiding your heroes through quests for treasure, battles with deadly foes, daring rescues, courtly intrigue, and much more.
- **Photography Club – Years 9 & 10;** You must have your own camera for this club. This is a skill-based learning club specifically for those who may wish to deepen their photography knowledge.
- **STEM – Years 7 & 8;** We are delighted to offer our pupils a great opportunity to explore, science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) through practical science experiments and design and build projects. Working together in small teams the pupils will take part in practical problem-solving activities that will boost their knowledge, enhance team working, inspire creativity and promote enjoyment in these key subject areas. The club is suitable for pupils of all abilities. **Cost for the term £5.**
- **Ballet & Tap with Dance & Beyond Years 1 & 2;** Ballet will make you feel elegant and graceful. Tap will help you discover your inner rhythm! Develop your musicality, co-ordination, and memory skills by experiencing both contrasting styles in this fun, confidence building class! Uniform and tap shoes are required for further details please contact Veronica@danceandbeyond.com cost for this club is **£13.50 per month.**
- **Tap & Funky Jazz with Dance & Beyond; Years 3 & 4;** Dance to high energy, upbeat music and cultivate your inner rhythm by learning both Tap and Funky Jazz routines! In these classes you will develop coordination, fitness and a stronger confidence to perform! - **Woodland Wanders Forest Club – Year 3; FOR THE SECOND HALF TERM ONLY This club finishes at 5pm.** There will be lots to keep your child entertained at forest school club and each week we will be offering something different for the children to learn, make and do. Ranging from fire lighting using a flint and steel, campfire cooking such as marshmallows, damper bread and pastries on sticks, using tools such as saws and peelers to make fun woodcraft items to take home, playing games, exploring, pond dipping, natural crafts and much more. You will require Wellies and thick socks, appropriate outdoor clothing (as they will be outside whatever the weather) and a water bottle. Cost for the second half term starting **Thursday 23 Feb – last session Thurs 1st April** is £35. Payment is direct to Jen of Woodland Forest School.
- **Sketching Club – Years 5 & 6;** Learn the skill of pencil drawing, a steady hand is required. Cost includes sketching equipment £10 for the term.
