Social and Emotional learning (2 lunchtimes x week 30 mins social club)	Increased understanding of emotional resilience and participation in learning. Develop self-confidence and esteem of PP students
Behaviour and Emotional support from LSAs	Increased participation in lessons and focus on learning. Develop self-confidence and esteem of PP students

Staff Training	Two members of staff undertook the core training for designated teachers for looked after children. One member of staff completed the training on Personal Education Plans for children in care with Hampshire
Touch Type Read and Spell	A multi-sensory course that teaches touch-typing to help children improve their reading and spelling skills. delivered by a specialist for one hour a week
