## **Year 4 Saxon to Tudor Trip – Weald & Downland Living Museum, Friday 5th June 2026**

### **Details**

As we begin our topic on the Saxons, we have arranged an interactive trip to the Weald & Downland Living Museum. This visit will give pupils a real insight into what life was like from the Saxon era through to the Tudor period. Pupils will be challenged to spot differences between the houses and will take part in immersive, hands-on activities at each stopping point. This is a fantastic learning experience that brings history to life.

We will travel to and from the museum by school minibus during the school day.

### **Cost and Payment Details**

The cost of the visit is **£10.50**. However, you will not need to contribute if you paid the annual Primary Trip contribution at the start of the school year, as consent was also given at that time. If any medical information has changed since then, please inform your child's class teacher. For parents who have not paid the annual contribution: if your child would like to take part in this workshop, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£10.50** to cover the cost of the visit.

Payment should be made via the school's ParentPay system, where you can also provide consent for your child to participate. If you do not have access to ParentPay, or are unsure whether you made the annual contribution, please contact the finance office.

If insufficient voluntary contributions are received, it is unlikely that the trip will go ahead. Please contact the school if you would like your child to participate but are experiencing difficulty making the contribution. If your child does not wish to attend the trip, they must still attend school, where alternative provision will be made. Normal school procedures for non-attendance will apply.

### **Items to Bring**

All pupils must come to school in their uniform, along with a suitable outer garment for spending time outdoors. Please ensure sun cream is applied before school, and a sun hat is recommended. A packed lunch will be required. If your child is eligible for FSM, a packed lunch can be provided—please inform your class teacher no later than Monday 1st June 2026.
