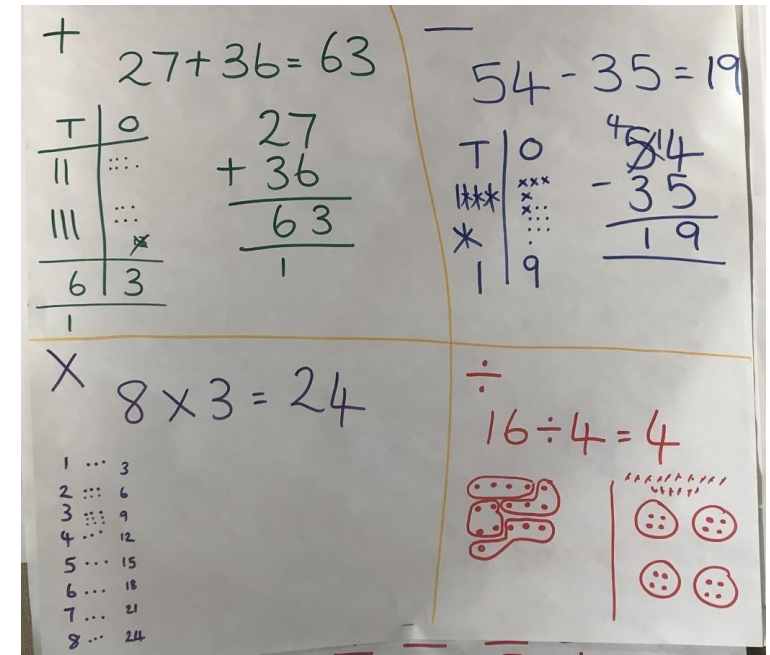

If you finish your book write a short book review about what you liked or didn't like.</p> <p>You can read your home books too. Have a go at making predictions about what might happen in the story and think about how the characters are feeling and how you know.</p>
